Oh No

RULES: USPSA Handgun Competition Rules, current edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** 1911 Single Stack Design Team

START POSITION: Standing in shooting area behind table, hands naturally at sides, loaded firearm and extra ammo on table.

STAGE PROCEDURE

String 1: On signal, engage targets with only two rounds each.

String 2: On signal, engage each target with only two rounds each.

Both strings will start with gun on the table. All ammo for the stage will be on the table. Gun is not to be propped up in any manner. All rounds must be fired from within the shooting area.

SCORING

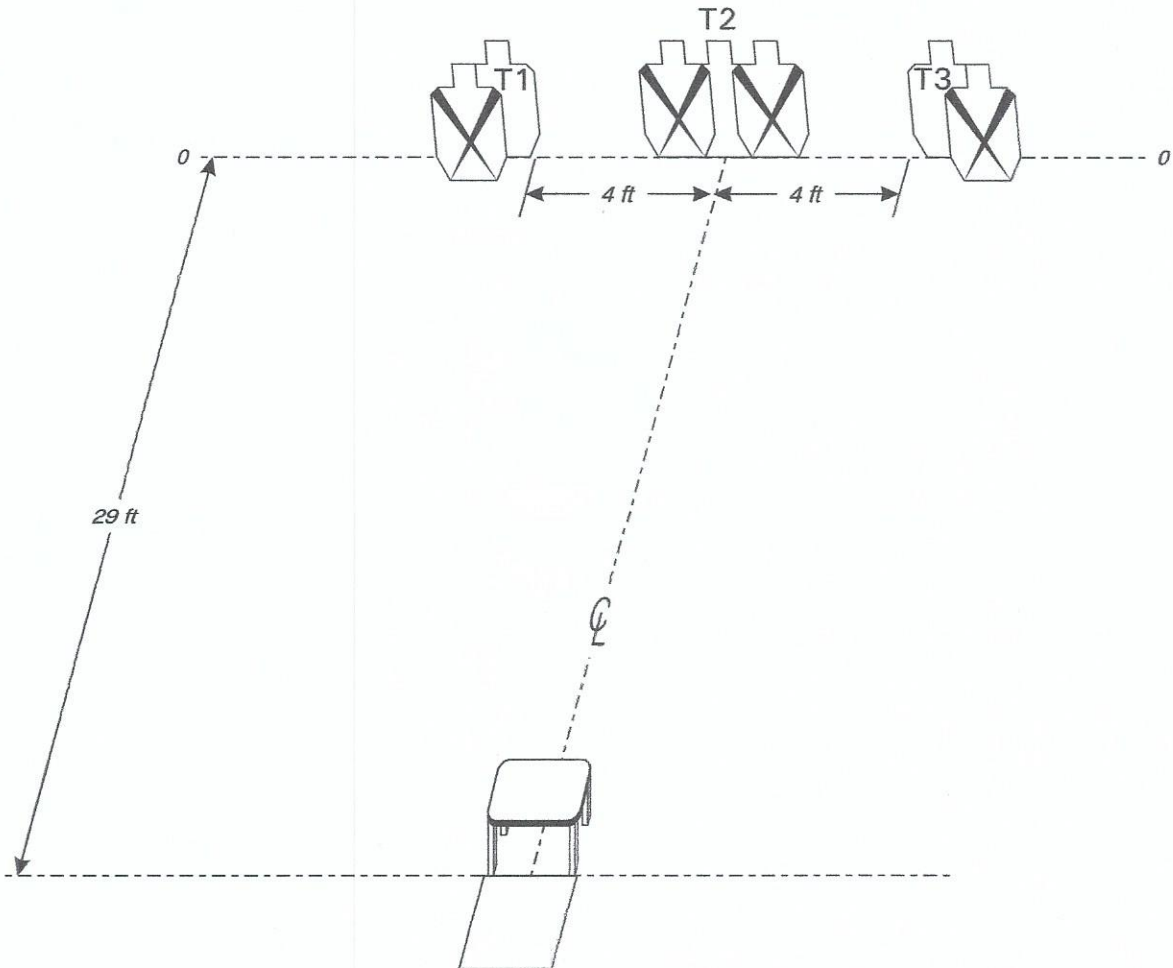
SCORING: Virginia Count, 12 rounds, 60 points

TARGETS: 3 Metric

SCORED HITS: Best 4/paper

START - STOP: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Per current edition of USPSA Handgun Competition Rules



SETUP NOTES: Shoot targets are 58 inches high at shoulders. Tabletop is 30 inches high. No-shoots on T1 and T3 are set so top of no-shoot is even with top of shoulder and the no-shoot's scoring line is vertically in the middle of the A-zone scoring line. No-shoots on T2



are set so the scoring lines overlay the A-zone scoring lines. T2 and both no-shoots are set to the same height.

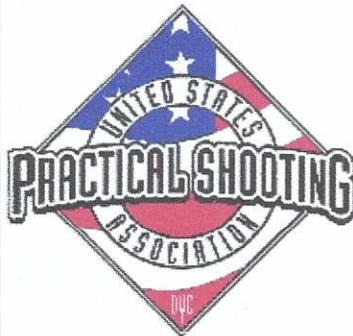
Written Stage Briefing

Oh No is a 12 round, 60 point Virginia Count Standards shot in two strings. There are 3 Metric targets. The best 4 hits per target will score. The start signal is audible.

The start position is standing inside the fault lines, behind the table, facing downrange with your hands relaxed at your sides. Your gun will be loaded and placed flat on the table muzzle down range with all extra ammo. Your gun may not be propped up in any manner. (Same for PCC)

String #1: On the start signal, engage each target with only 2 rounds freestyle, from within the fault lines.

String #2: On the start signal, draw and engage each target with only 2 rounds freestyle, from within the fault lines.



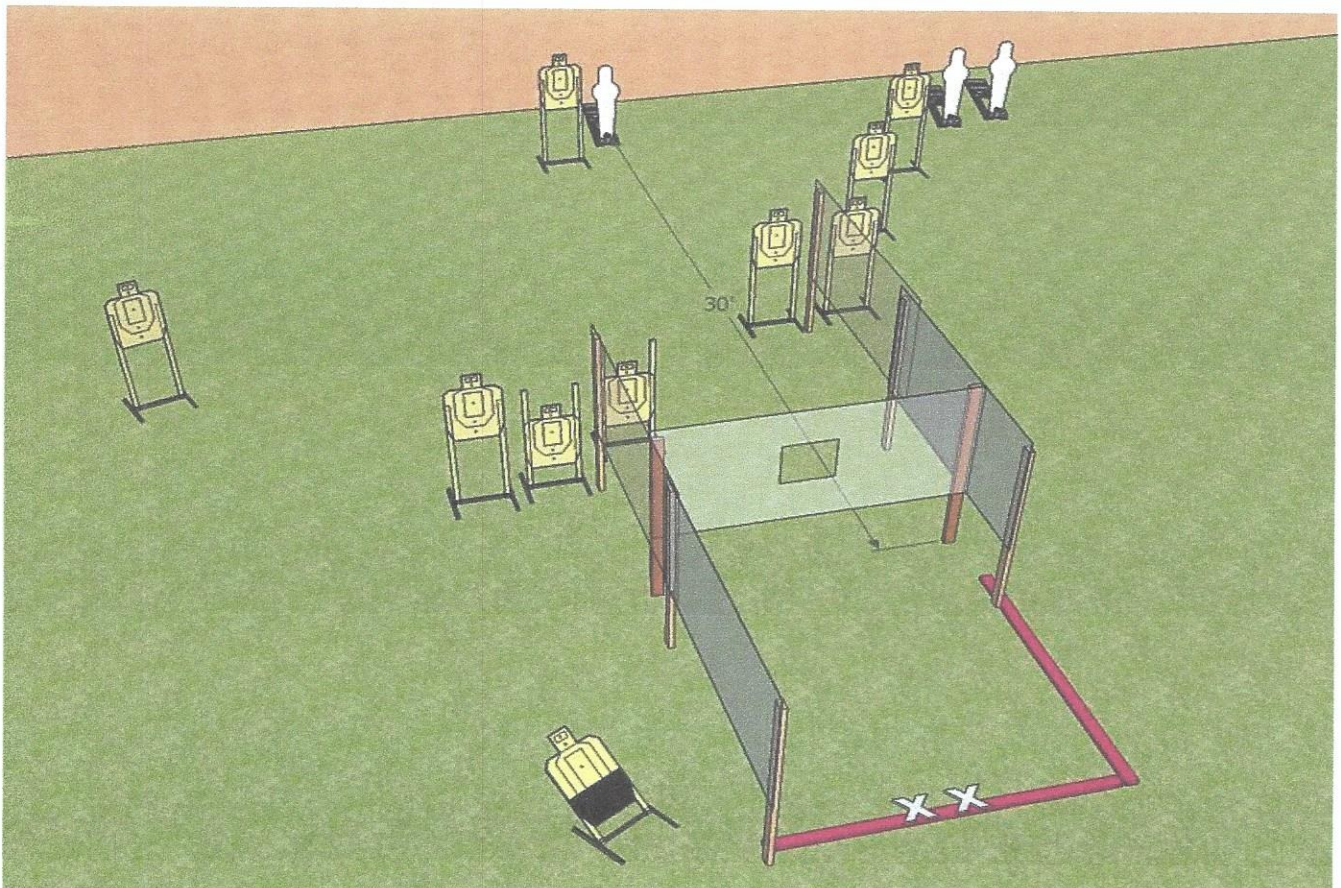
Would You Mind

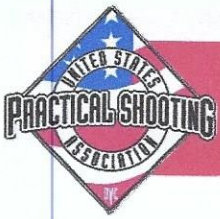
Would You Mind is a 23 round, 115 point **Comstock** course of fire. There are **10** metric targets and **3** poppers. The best **2** hits per target will score, steel must fall to score. The start signal is Audible.

The start position is standing completely **inside** the shooting area, facing **down** range with wrists **below belt**, **heels** touching X marks. Handgun is **loaded** and **holstered**.

PCC start position is standing completely **inside** the shooting area, facing down range, **heels** touching X marks. Stock on belt, muzzle pointed down range, **loaded** carbine **held in both hands with safety on**.

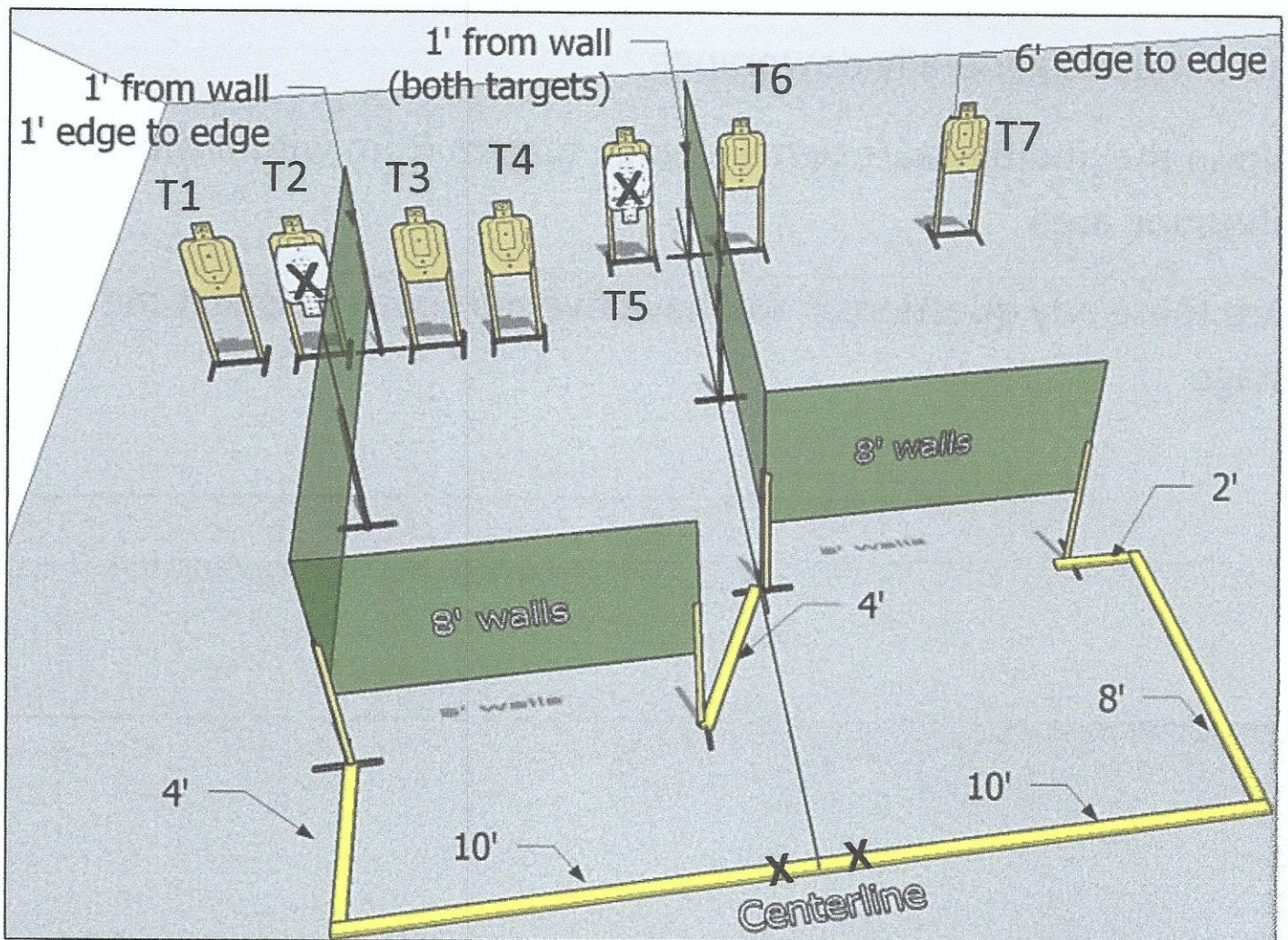
On the audible start signal, from within the shooting area, engage all targets as they become visible.

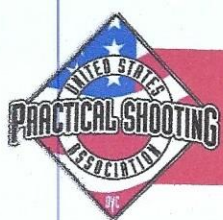




Set-up Notes

- All targets are 5 feet to top of head
- No-Shoots are inverted, 8 inches down from the top of the shoulder
- Rear fault line is 20 feet wide
- T2, T3, T5, T6 are 1 foot from wall
- T1-T2 and T3-T4 are 20 feet downrange from rear fault line
- T5 and T6-T7 are 24 feet downrange from rear fault line





Written Stage Briefing

Cross Road Blues is a 14 round Comstock course. There are 7 USPSA cardboard targets.

The start position is heels touching marks. Handgun loaded and holstered, wrists below belt. PCC is loaded with safety on, stock on belt, muzzle generally downrange.

Upon the audible start signal engage targets from within the shooting area.

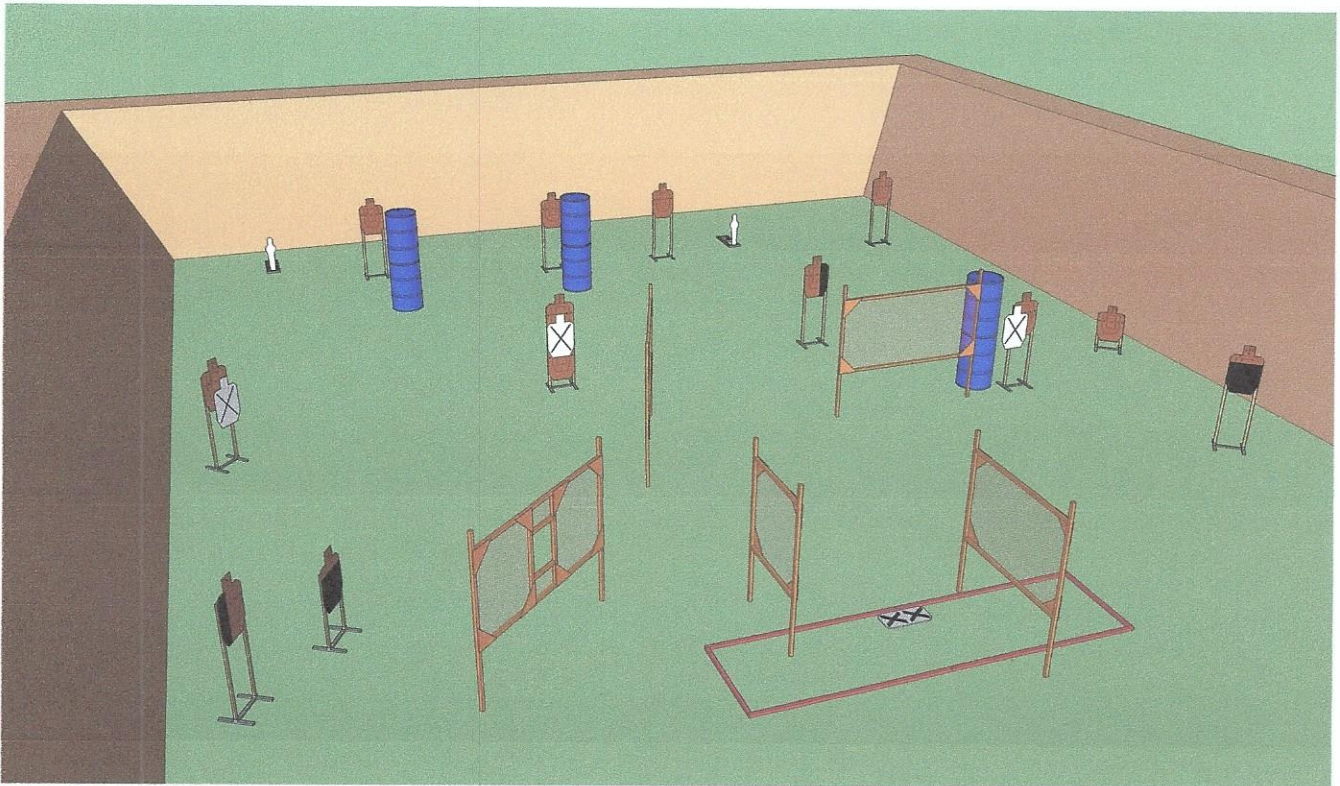
The Raptor

The Raptor is a **28** round, **140** point **Comstock** course of fire. There are **13** metric targets, and **2** mini poppers. The best **2** hits per target will score, steel must fall to score. The start signal is Audible.

The start position is standing **inside** the shooting area, facing **down** range with wrists **below belt**, **toes** touching X marks. Handgun is **loaded** and **holstered**.

PCC start position is standing **inside** the shooting area, facing down range, **toes** touching X marks. Stock on belt, muzzle pointed down range, **loaded** carbine **held in both hands with safety on**.

On the audible start signal, from within the shooting area, engage all targets as they become visible.



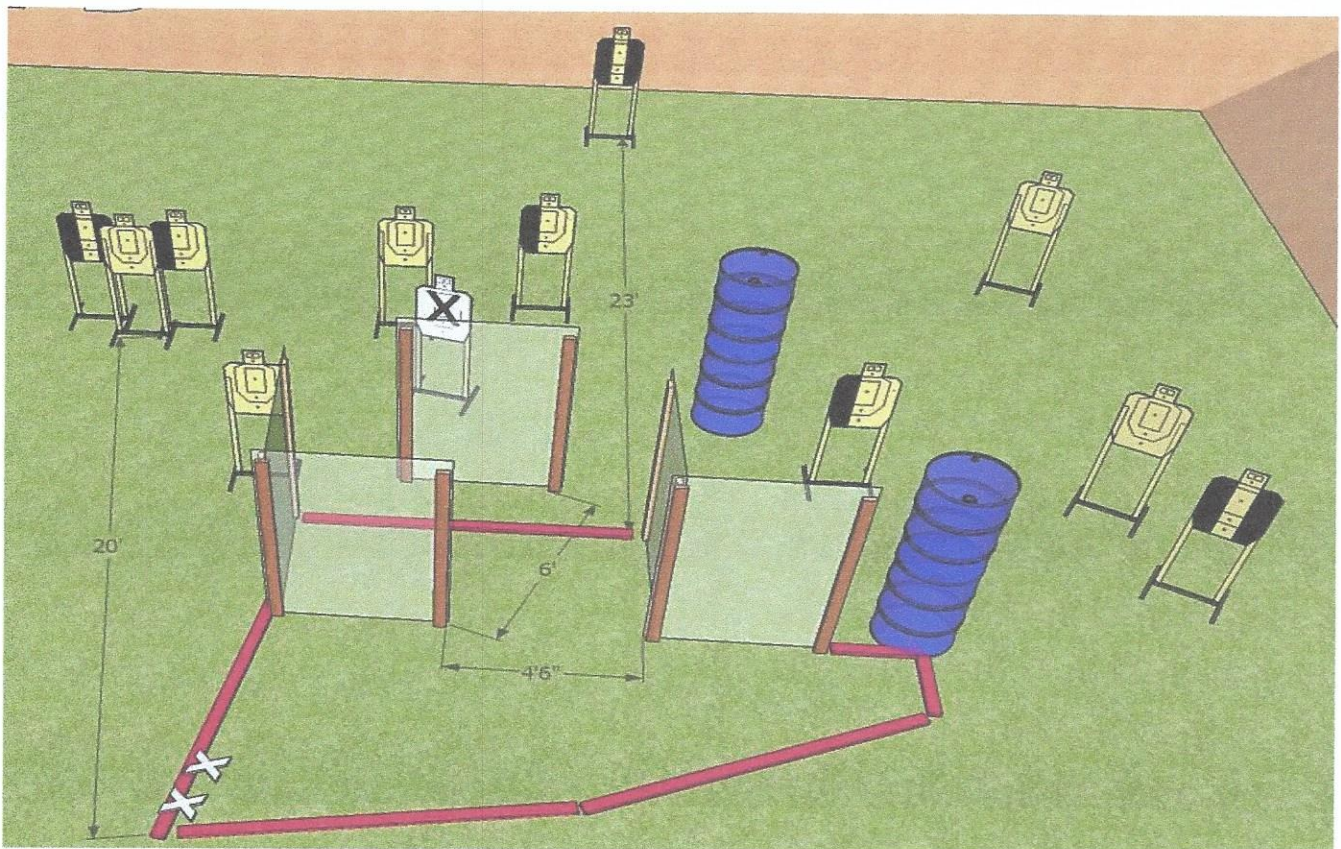
Hooked Instantly

Hooked Instantly is a 22 round, 110 point **Comstock** course of fire. There are 11 metric targets. The best 2 hits per target will score, steel must fall to score. The start signal is Audible.

The start position is standing **outside** the shooting area, facing **down** range with wrists **below belt**, **toes** touching X marks. Handgun is **loaded** and **holstered**.

PCC start position is standing **outside** the shooting area, facing down range, **toes** touching X marks. Stock on belt, muzzle pointed down range, **loaded** carbine **held in both hands with safety on**.

On the audible start signal, from within the shooting area, engage all targets as they become visible.



Some Kind of Shoe

Some Kind of Shoe is a **30** round, **150** point **Comstock** course of fire. There are **14** METRIC targets and **2** poppers. The best **2** hits per target will score, steel must fall to score. The start signal is Audible.

The start position is standing **inside** the shooting area, facing **down** range with wrists **below belt**, **heels** touching either set of X marks. Handgun is **loaded** and **holstered**.

PCC start position is standing **inside** the shooting area, facing down range, **heels** touching either set of X marks. Stock on belt, muzzle pointed down range, **loaded** carbine **held in both hands with safety on**.

On the audible start signal, from within the shooting area, engage all targets as they become visible.
